

Town of Windsor Youth Soccer Code of Conduct

In order to promote teamwork and mutual respect between players, coaches, referees, parents and spectators, the Town of Windsor Youth Board has established a “Code of Conduct”. This Code shall act as a guide in setting clear expectations for the actions of players, coaches, parents and spectators of the town soccer league.

This Code was not designed to address every possible behavioral circumstance. However, it shall serve as the Youth Board’s standard for behavioral evaluation. It shall be the obligation of ALL program participants, spectators, parents and volunteers to comply with these Codes. Any person violating the Code shall be subject to administrative action, up to and including termination of his/her privilege to participate in, or attend, any or all town sponsored activities.

All participants, parents, spectators and volunteers will:

- ▶ not ridicule or demean players, coaches or referees
- ▶ treat all players, coaches and referees fairly and with respect regardless of play, decision or call
- ▶ respect the opponent and avoid any confrontation with opposing players, spectators or coaches.
- ▶ not engage in any kind of unsportsmanlike conduct with any referee, coach, player or parent, such as booing and taunting
- ▶ not use abusive or profane language
- ▶ not appear on the field, stands or elsewhere near the playing field while intoxicated
- ▶ not have tobacco products in the dugouts and surrounding areas
- ▶ inform the coach of any disability or ailment that may affect the safety of their child
- ▶ make every attempt to have their son/daughter attend practices and games on time

Failure to abide by this Code of Conduct, will result in the following: First offense, you will be spoken to by an official, head coach, and/or head of league organization. Second offense, you will be asked to leave the area. If you do not leave, the game will be stopped. This may also result in a forfeiture.

Please note that the Windsor Youth Program has a zero tolerance policy. This applies to conduct at games played on other fields in the event the Windsor teams travel to play soccer. We make every effort to create a happy, wholesome atmosphere where the children can play and learn the game of soccer.

**REMEMBER: CHILDREN PARTICIPATE TO HAVE FUN AND
THE GAME IS FOR THE YOUTH, NOT ADULTS.**

The Code of Conduct must be reviewed and signed by a parent or guardian before the start of the season.
