Our program truly embraces the meaning of recreational soccer by practicing and playing games without the added pressure of record and scorekeeping. We do our best to reassure that kids associate soccer with having fun, in the hope that they will continue to play into their teen and adult years. We play age appropriate small-sided games using team and field sizes recommended by NYSWYSA.

PARENT'S OBLIGATION

Your registration fee will help pay for uniforms, referees, field maintenance and supplies. However, the league is only as good as the volunteers who take the time to help coach, maintain the fields, or assist with Booster Club activities. Please consider volunteering for one of these worthwhile functions.

Please do not leave your children at the fields for practices or games unattended. Coaches cannot be responsible for attending to the personal needs of your child while they are involved with running practices or games.

We have a zero tolerance for yelling, screaming and out-of control parents. Our referees and coaches do the best job they can and verbal abuse to them will not be tolerated.
